2. Fire. 12/01 car accident on I-95, 12/04 Fire call to Persistence, 12/18 Stage for mutual aid to Carmel, 12/23 Multiple calls, Ice Storm, 12/24 Notification of warming facility, 12/26 Tree across road at 1152 North Rd., 12/31 Mutual aid to Hampden.
3. Roads. Kimball Rd., The plow needs to have a turnaround spot. Thurlough Rd. some residents are plowing snow across the road and making it difficult to plow, Brent will speak to them and advise them that it is against Maine law to plow across the road. Haskell Rd., a resident has sent a request that the town stop all road work on the Haskell Rd., it would have to be discontinued as a town road to stop any road work.
